



Cisco Catalyst 8500/LightStream 1010 IOS Release 12.1(19)EB

Introduction

This Product Bulletin describes the content and delivery information concerning Cisco IOS™ software release 12.1(19)EB. It should be used in conjunction with Product Bulletin titles, Cisco IOS Software Release 12.1E. 12.1(19)EB is an Early Deployment (ED) release supporting Cisco Catalyst 8510/8540 MSR and Lightstream 1010 platforms.

New Features in 12.1(19)EB

New features are supported on the Cisco Catalyst 8510MSR, 8540MSR, and Lightstream 1010

Detailed Information

Redundancy Support for P2MP SPVC

Point to Multipoint (P2MP) Soft PVC's (SPVC) were added as a feature to the Catalyst 8500 MSR in release 12.1(13)EB. However, P2MP SPVC's were not preserved during a switchover from the Primary Router Processor (RP) to the Secondary RP. In release 12.1(19)EB, P2MP SPVC are now preserved during switchover.

Redundancy Support for SSHKey

Prior to release 12.1(19)EB, SSH Keys would require manual regeneration after switchover from the Primary RP to the Secondary RP. In release 12.1(19)EB, SSH Keys are now preserved during switchover.

Support for SSHv2 Server

Release 12.1(19)EB adds support for SSHv2 server. Support for SSHv2 client is planned for a future release.



Password Protection for Enable Mode on Secondary RP

Prior to release 12.1(19)EB, there was no password to enter enable mode on the Secondary RP. This could allow the system configuration to be altered without proper permissions. Release 12.1(19)EB adds support for Password Protection on the Secondary RP.

Coredump Generation on Secondary RP

Prior to release 12.1(19)EB, a crash on the Secondary RP would not be able to be captured via a system coredump. Release 12.1(19)EB adds support for Coredump Generation on the Secondary RP.

Switchover Duration Timer

The duration of the switchover from the Primary RP to the Secondary RP varies depending upon multiple factors such as number of connections, size of configuration, network performance, etc. Release 12.1(19)EB adds a Switchover Duration Timer to aid network managers in monitoring system switchovers.

Low Impact Software Migration

Prior to release 12.1(19)EB, ATM Virtual Circuits (VC) which were established in the system would be guaranteed to be preserved during a switchover only when both the Primary RP and Secondary RP were running the same version of software. Release 12.1(19)EB guarantees preservation of VC's during switchover when migrating between different versions of software. Both versions must be 12.1(19)EB or greater. Migration can be either from an older version of software to a newer version or in the reverse direction.
