Remove the automatic reboot that takes place when the LAN configuration is modified. Although the system doesn't reboot, there is about 10 seconds of down time affecting all traffic for the LAN and VLAN.

Issues Resolved Since Cisco RV180 and RV180W Firmware Version 1.0.0.30

- PPPoE fix for HTTP browsing
- Manufacturing command support for firmware version, reset to default
- Fixed an issue in which web pages were not loading properly in Internet Explorer 8. (CSCtq58125)

Known Issues in Firmware Version 1.0.1.9

- Traffic does not follow the bandwidth limit when the traffic selector is set to VLAN, DSCP or SSID. (CSCtr24497)
 Work Around: Use an IP range instead. To edit a profile binding rule, go to the QoS > Profile Binding page, find the rule in the table, and then click Edit. On the Add / Edit Profile Binding Configuration page, Traffic Selector Match Type field, select IP Address Range, and then enter the starting and ending addresses.
- On the Status > Port Statistics page, the statistics in the Packets column are not updating to show the current number of transmitted and received packets. (CSCtt41705)
- Enabling or disabling multiple SSIDs at once is taking longer than 1 minute. (CSCtq78773)
- The DHCP server is taking more than 2 minutes to assign IP addresses when the router is configured in non-routing mode. (CSCtq52971)
