This chapter describes the Cisco NX-OS Policy Based Routing (PBR) commands that begin with C.

# clear route-map pbr-statistics

To clear policy-based statistics for a route map, use the **clear route-map pbr statistics** command.

**clear route-map** *name* **pbr-statistics**

<b>Syntax Description</b>	<i>name</i> Name of the route map. The name can be any alphanumeric string up to 63 characters.	
<b>Command Default</b>	None	
<b>Supported User Roles</b>	Any network-admin vdc-admin	
<b>Command History</b>	<b>Release</b> 6.0(2)N2(1)	<b>Modified</b> This command was introduced.
<b>Usage Guidelines</b>	Use the <b>clear route-map pbr-statistics</b> command to clear policy-based routing statistics enabled by the <b>route-map pbr-statistics</b> command.  This command requires the Enterprise Services license.	
<b>Examples</b>	This example shows how to clear the policy-based routing statistics for a route map:  <pre>switch# clear route-map testmap pbr-statistics</pre>
