Changes to the Software

- Supports new GUI Style
- Uses "admin" as the default user name and "admin" as the default password

Limitations and Restrictions

- Changing the IP address of the system from DHCP to static IP address disables Bonjour.

Workaround: After changing the IP address from DHCP to static IP address, the user can go to the "Discovery-Bonjour" page to disable Bonjour service by unchecking the "Enable Discovery" box, then click on "Save Settings". Then, re-enable Bonjour service by checking "Enable Discovery" box.

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
