Unset Commands

This chapter contains the following **unset** commands:

unset network

unset network dns options [**timeout**] [**attempts**] [**rotate**]

Syntax Description	timeout	Sets the wait time before the system considers a DNS query as failed to the default.
	attempts	Sets the number of DNS attempts to make before failing to the default.
	rotate	Sets the method for selecting a nameserver to the default. This affects how loads are distributed across nameservers.

Command Modes	Admin
	Command privilege level: 1

Command History	Release	Modifications
	1.2	This command was first documented.

Usage Guidelines	This command unsets DNS options.
	The system asks whether you want to continue to execute this command.



Caution

If you continue, the system will temporarily lose network connectivity.
