# trace backuprestore

To enable tracing for specified entities or activities, use the **trace backuprestore** command in Cisco Unified Messaging Gateway (Cisco UMG) EXEC mode.

**trace backuprestore { all | backuprestore {conf | history | init | operation | server | all } }**

Syntax Description	all	Every entity and activity
	<b>backuprestore all</b>	All
	<b>backuprestore conf</b>	Activity
	<b>backuprestore history</b>	Activity
	<b>backuprestore init</b>	Activity
	<b>backuprestore operation</b>	Activity
	<b>backuprestore server</b>	Activity

# trace umg global

To enable tracing for specified entities or activities, use the **trace umg global** command in Cisco Unified Messaging Gateway (Cisco UMG) EXEC mode.

```
trace umg global { 0_crash | 1_error | 2_warn | 3_debug | 4_info | all }
```

# trace umg registration

trace umg registration { 0_crash | 1_error | 2_warn | 3_debug | 4_info | all }
```

# trace umg routing

To enable tracing for specified entities or activities, use the **trace umg routing** command in Cisco Unified Messaging Gateway (Cisco UMG) EXEC mode.

```
trace umg routing { all | gateway | monitor | route | sender | spool }
```

Syntax Description	
<b>all</b>	Every entity and activity
<b>gateway</b>	Activity
<b>monitor</b>	Activity
<b>route</b>	Activity
<b>sender</b>	Activity
<b>spool</b>	Activity

# translation-rule

To configure the translation rule for the message or SMTP header for each supported endpoint, use the **translation-rule** command in Cisco Unified Messaging Gateway (Cisco UMG) configuration mode.

```
translation-rule { smtp | message } {cue | interchange | umg | unity } { from-user umg-user |
from-host { text | umg-host } | to-host { text | umg-host }
```

<b>Syntax Description</b>	
<b>message</b>	Configure message header translation rules.
<b>smtp</b>	Configure SMTP header translation rules.
<b>cue</b>	Configure message or SMTP header translation rules for <Abbreviation>Cisco Unity Express.
<b>interchange</b>	Configure message or SMTP header translation rules for Avaya Interchange.
<b>umg</b>	Configure message or SMTP header translation rules for Cisco UMG.
<b>unity</b>	Configure message or SMTP header translation rules for Cisco Unity.
<b>from-host</b>	Configure src-host translation rules for an endpoint.
<b>from-host text</b>	Set source e-mail domain value.
<b>from-host umg-host</b>	Variable name used for src-host translation.
<b>from-user</b>	Configure src-user translation rules for an endpoint.
<b>from-user umg-user</b>	Variable name used for src-user translation.
<b>to-host</b>	Configure dest-host translation rules for an endpoint.
<b>to-host text</b>	Set destination e-mail domain value.
<b>to-host umg-host</b>	Variable name used for dest-host translation.
<b>to-user</b>	Configure dest-user translation rules for an endpoint.
<b>to-user umg-user</b>	Variable name used for dest-user translation.

Cisco Unity uses the ‘Message Header To:’ line, and Avaya Interchange uses the ‘SMTP Envelop From:’ and the ‘Message Envelope From:’.</p>

```
umg-1# config t
umg-1(config)# translation-rule smtp cue from-host mycompany.com
Save the change to startup configuration and reload the module for the new configuration
to take effect.
umg-1(config)# end
umg-1# show translation-rule message
