Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco IOS XR Software Release 4.0. The last day to order the affected product(s) is April 1, 2012. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product(s). Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available until the termination date of the contract, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.
