

## End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Access Point HWIC Supporting Japanese 5-GHz Radio Regulatory Requirements (with part number HWIC-AP-AG-J)

Cisco Systems® announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Access Point HWIC Supporting Japanese 5-GHz Radio Regulatory Requirements (with part number HWIC-AP-AG-J). The last day to order the Access Point HWIC Supporting Japanese 5-GHz Radio Regulatory Requirements (with part number HWIC-AP-AG-J) is January 12, 2007. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin.

Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the Access Point HWIC Supporting Japanese 5-GHz Radio Regulatory Requirements (with part number HWIC-AP-AG-J). Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement.

Milestone	Definition	Date
<b>End-of-Sale Date</b>	The last date to order the product through Cisco point-of-sale mechanisms. The product is no longer for sale after this date.	January 12, 2007
<b>Last Ship Date: HW</b>	The last-possible ship date that can be requested of Cisco and/or its contract manufacturers. Actual ship date is dependent on lead time.	January 12, 2007
<b>End of Routine Failure Analysis Date: HW</b>	The last-possible date a routine failure analysis may be performed to determine the cause of product failure or defect.	July 8, 2008
<b>End of New Service Attachment Date: HW</b>	For equipment and software that is not covered by a service-and-support contract, this is the last date to order a new service-and-support contract or add the equipment and/or software to an existing service-and-support contract.	July 8, 2008
<b>End of Service Contract Renewal Date: HW</b>	The last date to extend or renew a service contract for the product.	October 4, 2011
<b>Last Date of Support: HW</b>	The last date to receive service and support for the product. After this date, all support services for the product are unavailable, and the product becomes obsolete.	July 7, 2012
