

End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco License Manager 2.0

Cisco® announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco License Manager 2.0. The last day to order the affected product(s) is March 27, 2009. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available until the termination date of the contract, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.
