End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco ONS 15327 E-Series Cards

Cisco Systems[®] announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco ONS 15327 E-Series Cards. The last day to order the affected product is July 10, 2007. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) until July 8, 2012. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product. Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement.

The Cisco ONS 15310-MA and ONS 15310-CL are replacement platforms for the Cisco ONS 15327. Customers are encouraged to migrate to the ONS 15310 CE-Series and ML-Series cards on ONS 15310 platforms. Table 2 provides relevant information for migrating to the replacement product.
