



End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco IOS XE Software Release 2.3

Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of life dates for the Cisco IOS XE Software Release 2.3. The last day to order the affected product(s) is November 27, 2009. This End-of-Sale announcement covers all maintenance releases of IOS XE 2.3 (including 2.3.0, 2.3.1, and later versions). Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product(s). Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available until the termination date of the contract, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.

Cisco IOS XE Software provides enhanced in-service software upgrade (ISSU) and high-availability (HA) features. These features allow network operators to upgrade Cisco ASR 1000 Series Routers without incurring any significant service interruption.
