Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco Content Delivery Engine 220 - Dense Internet Flash Streamer and Internet Content Acquirer Models 2S3I and 2G2. The last day to order the affected product(s) is October 4, 2012.
