

## End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Series 8000 Digital Cable Set-Tops

Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco® Series 8000 Digital Cable Set-Tops. The last day to order the affected product(s) is September 2, 2011. For customers with active service contracts or active product warranties, support will be available for the shown dates as stated in the applicable service contracts or product warranty terms and conditions, even if this date exceeds the Last Date of Support shown in Table 1.
