New Features

Cisco Video Surveillance 2500 Series IP Camera Firmware Version 2.1 includes the following features:

- **Cisco Media API:** Firmware Version 2.1 adds support for the Cisco Media API, an open, standards-based interface that allows integration with compatible video surveillance management systems.
- **MJPEG encoding:** Firmware Version 2.1 adds support for MJPEG encoding.
- **802.1x authentication:** Firmware Version 2.1 adds support for 802.1x authentication on the Ethernet interface of the wired Cisco Video Surveillance 2500 Series IP Camera. 802.1x authentication for the wireless interface has been supported since the inception of the wireless version of the 2500 Series IP Camera.
- **Bonjour zero configuration:** Firmware Version 2.1 adds support for the Bonjour zero configuration discovery protocol.
