# End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco 2700 Wireless Location Appliance

Cisco Systems© announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco© 2700 Wireless Location Appliance. The last day to order the affected product is May 24, 2006. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) until August 15, 2011.

Customers are encouraged to migrate to the Cisco 2710 Wireless Location Appliance of the Cisco 2700 Series. All successor products are fully compatible with Cisco's suite of Lightweight Access Point Protocol (LWAPP) products for the <u>Cisco Unified Wireless Network</u>. End-of-Sale Date	The last date to order the product through Cisco point-of-sale mechanisms. The product is no longer for sale after this date.	May 24, 2006
End of Routine Failure Analysis Date	The last-possible date a routine failure analysis may be performed to determine the cause of product failure or defect.	August 16, 2007
End of New Service Attachment Date	For equipment and software that is not covered by a service-and-support contract, this is the last date to order a new service-and-support contract or add the equipment and/or software to an existing service-and-support contract.	August 16, 2007
End of Service Contract Renewal Date	The last date to extend or renew a service contract for the product.	November 11, 2010
