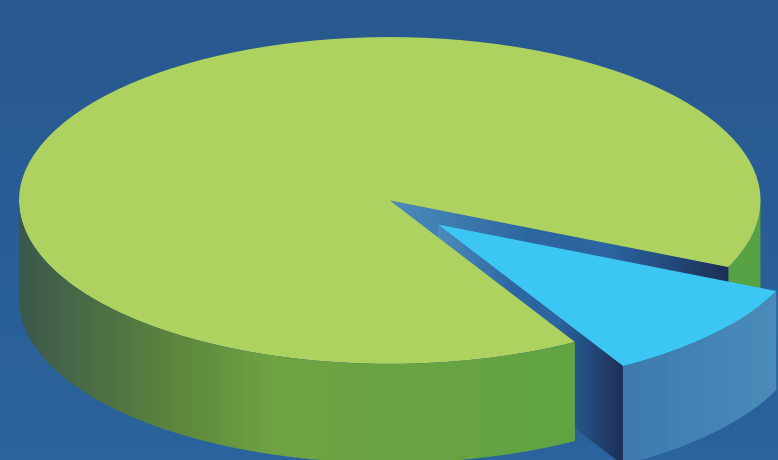

5 Automation

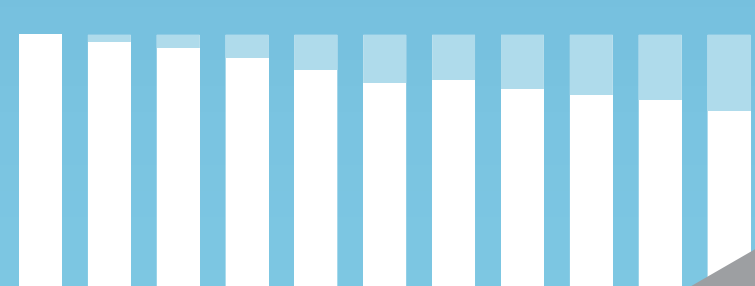
