Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Local and State Programs

JAG funds can be used for state and local public safety initiatives.

Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program

Recognizes that sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking are crimes that require the criminal justice system to hold offenders accountable for their actions.

Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation (CTAS)

Provides federally recognized tribes and tribal consortia an opportunity to develop a comprehensive and coordinated approach to public safety and victimization issues.

Assistance to Firefighters Grants (AFG)

Award one-year grants directly to fire departments and non-affiliated emergency medical services (EMS) organizations in order to enhance their abilities with respect to fire and fire related hazards.

Goals and activities must be aimed at increasing the safety, permanency, and well-being of children in the child welfare system.

Second Chance Act Family-Based Offender

Designed to implement or expand family-based treatment programs for adult individuals (18 years and over) in prison or jails.
